**303/14\_11/14/00016:** Application for the formation of second cattery unit comprising 3 units in a fenced compound at the RSPCA Centre Brent Road

**304/14: 07/14/00021:** Erection of a single storey extension to West Elevation at 2, Manor Ride Brent Knoll. The Parish Council supported the proposal on the grounds that it enabled the village to retain a young family locally and that the property was in keeping with general surroundings
