242/22: DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

Cllr R Filmer Other Registerable interest (ORI) on all matters relating to his role as County Councillor and District Councillor and member of the Parish Hall. A dispensation granted on the 5th October re stated on matters relating to shareholding in the Community shop and is further declared at this meeting. 07/23/00006: Erection of first floor extension with two storey extension to the NE and SW elevations and formation of new vehicular access. **at 65, Brent Street Brent Knoll.**

Response:

The Parish Council objected to this application on the grounds of over development of the site and out of keeping with the local Street Scene

07/23/00007: Erection of two detached dwellings (revised Scheme) **on Land at Journeys End Station Road Brent Knoll**

Response:

The Parish Council supported this application on the grounds of increasing accommodation and maintaining the character of the area and the village

244/22: Payment to local Contractor

The Council has received an Invoice in the sum of **£420.00** inc Vat for work done near the water tanks. The Council made a resolution to make the payment as a one off

gesture of goodwill however the Parish Council are not accepting any ongoing liability for this area as it is not owned by the Parish Council. The Parish Council also decided not to accept any quotation for work to the footpath to the side of the Water Board site.

245/22: Working group for shop Build

As part of the shop building process the Parish Council resolved to approve a working group without delegated powers to oversee the demolition of the toilet block and the building of a proposed shop. This working group will comprise Cllr R Filmer , Cllr C Townsend Cllr S Bougourd and Owen Cullwick clerk. This decision was taken by a majority vote.
